LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-K (age 2-3): This level is designed for ages 2 and 3, or students just starting out in pre-school. The focus of the class is on introducing children to dance, as well as to the structure of a class. Through creative movement, engaging music, games, and dance, children will begin to understand the fundamentals of ballet and general dance technique.

Pre-K (age 4): This level is designed for dancers who are 4 turning 5, or students who are in their final year of pre-school. Slightly more advanced than Pre-K (ages 2-3) in structure and pace, the focus of the class is on introducing children to dance, as well as to the structure of a class. Through creative movement, engaging music, games, and dance, children will begin to understand the fundamentals of ballet and tap.

Mini 1: This level is designed for ages 5 and 6, or Kingergarten-First Grade. At this level, we offer a combination class of ballet and tap, as well as additional classes in hip-hop, musical theatre, and acrobatics.

Mini 2: This level is designed for ages 7 and 8 or Second and Third Grade. At this level, we offer a combination classes of ballet, tap, & jazz, as well as additional classes in hip-hop, modern/lyrical, musical theatre, and acrobatics.

Petite: This level is designed for ages 9-11, or Fourth and Fifth Grade. At this level, we offer a a full ballet class, tap & jazz combination class, hiphop, modern/lyrical, musical theatre, and acrobatics. At this age, we begin focusing more heavily on technical dance elements like body alignment, flexibility, and strength. All full-length EDA class offerings are available to this level.

Junior: This level is designed for dancers ages 11-12, or 6th and 7th grade. Technique classes at the junior level are intermediate paced, but are open to all who are age-eligible. Dancers are expected to understand and follow the dance class structure, retain information week to week, and apply corrections to progress. All full-length EDA class offerings are available to this level.

Senior Intermediate: This level is designed for ages 13-15. This level is a bridge between the junior and senior advanced levels, and moves at an intermediate/advanced pace. Dancers are expected to understand and follow the dance class structure, retain information week to week, and apply corrections to progress. Dancers at this level begin to develop skills in artistry and improvisation.

Senior Advanced: This level is designed for advanced high school students. This level moves at a faster pace than the senior intermediate level, and is designed for dancers with at least a few years of experience. Dancers are expected to understand and follow the dance class structure, retain information week to week, and apply corrections to progress. Dancers at this level continue to develop skills in artistry and improvisation. All full-length EDA class offerings are available to these levels.

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE

EDA uses an online software system called DanceStudio-Pro to process registration, payment, and student enrollment. We find this system is convenient and user-friendly. Parents may register and pay for classes through an online Parent Portal, print a class schedule, and more.

HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE:

- Go to enchanteddanceacademy.com -click the sign-in button directing you to the DSP sign-in page.
- Create an account or log in to your existing DSP portal. Add dancers to your account.
- Click "register for classes" on your home page.
- Select classes from the listed available classes to register your dancers.
- See your total bill and pay online.

PRE-K (AGES 2-3)

Option 1: Pink leotard, pink or skin-colored tights, pink or skin-colored ballet shoes, black tap shoes, optional pink skirt

Option 2: Pink, or white plain tee-shirt/tank top, black athletic pants or shorts

PRE-K (age 4)

Option 1: Light blue leotard, pink or skin-colored tights, pink or skin-colored ballet shoes, black tap shoes, optional light blue skirt

Option 2: Light blue or white plain tee-shirt/tank top, black athletic pants or shorts

MINI 1

Option 1: Lavender leotard, skin-colored tights (ballet/tap) / Lavender leotard, black leggings (hip-hop & acro)

Option 2: Lavender or white plain tee-shirt/tank top, black athletic pants or shorts

MINI 2

Option 1: Maroon leotard, skin-colored stirrup tights, optional skirt (ballet, tap, & jazz) / Maroon leotard, black leggings (hip-hop & acro)

Option 2: Maroon plain tee-shirt/tank top, black athletic pants or shorts

PETITE / JUNIOR / SENIOR

Black leotard OR dance/athletic top, skin-colored stirrup tights and/or black athletic bottoms

*Please note, warmup clothes (dance jackets, sweatshirts, long sleeve shirts, etc.) are welcomed as long as they are the same SOLID color as their designated dress code and are designed for movement. We want dancers to feel confident in class.

SHOES

Dancers arrive/depart in easy slip-on/slip-off street shoes. Staff will assist with dance shoe changes.

BALLET

Ages 9+: pink or skin-colored canvas ballet shoes Up to age 9: full-sole leather ballet shoes

TAP

Ages 9+: black tie-up tap shoes Up to age 9: black beginner velcro tap shoes

JAZZ/MUSICAL THEATRE

nude slip-on jazz shoes

HIP-HOP

plain black hip-hop sneakers (NO street shoes)

LYRICAL

half-sole pirouette shoes

MODERN/CONTEMPORARY/ACROBATICS

bare feet
